**“Fair Play & Respect”**: Recommend Grades 6-12

Many Albertan athletes have achieved their Olympic dreams but not without obstacles to overcome. Students will discover some incredible stories about local athletes that have paved the way for fair play and respect in Olympic competition and exemplified the true meaning of moral ethics in sport.

Our 9-12 programs consist of 45 minutes of educational instruction, a physical literacy component followed by a brief museum tour and free time to play!

All programs include learning about the preservation of Alberta’s sports history, archiving, and the care and handling of artefacts.



Objectives:

- Students will come to recognize the importance of fair play and respect in sports and the consequences that come with unfair play
- Students will recognize individual Albertan athletes that have contributed to a strong history of moral ethics in sports.
- Students will leave with a better appreciation for the hard work that goes into sports and the importance of respect and honesty amongst competitors, coaches and judges
